II. Stock medication Policy

The Indiana General Assembly has passed the Emergency Medication Policy to allow schools to voluntarily stock medication for students

Cindy- advised that FAQ document exist about this process

Lindsay has worked with Monroe cty Schools to fully implement this before law

Also working with Hammond schools for implementation

Lindsay worked on process from start to finish

Action 1- Discuss with Dona Roberts any and all actions being taken by IDOE for this process

Step 1 - purchased a compressor, and given a neb cup and mask (\$65 nebilzer)

Schools need a MD to sign medical authorization

Step 2-The documentation is some type of “administration policy” then

Step 3 the school has to the complete the report that goes to IDOE

Action 2

Recommendation to develop a toolkit on the website- InJAC can update school nurses that this law exist by sending an email notice to nurses

InJAC can have portal for templates of other school’s policies that can be used by them

Provide Survey monkey for feedback from school nurses, admin etc on injac website

Market this at school nurses conference in November
